Host Village Facilities Information:

- Large sites with fire pits and charcoal grill
- Full Hook-up Site
- Electric Power: 30/50 Amp
- Wi-Fi
- Cell Phone Service: Limited Reception with Verizon, US Cellular – Good
- Activity Building: Full Kitchen, Fire Place, 3 Washers and 3 dryers, 2 Full Bathrooms.
- Fire Wood available
- Host Social Events (Pot Lucks, Game Nights, Group Fires)

Things to consider:

- Distance to downtown Brevard: 15 miles
- Distance to Pisgah Forest: 11 miles
- Hwy 276 is the only Road in, the road is very congested during Peak season.
- Distance to Blue Ridge Parkway: 3.5 miles
- Gift Shop includes working in QuickBooks POS and processing credit cards

Is Cradle of Forestry Heritage Site right for you?

- Working with the Public
- Working with School groups (K – 12<sup>th</sup> )
- Interpretive Skills in educating public on the Cradle of Forestry Heritage Site (including walking trails)
- A lot of walking, Example: 1 mile to Open Historic Buildings and 1 mile to close Historic Buildings = 2 miles (potentially 2 –4 miles a day) and Standing
- Work in Inclement Weather
- Living where you work? The hosts you work with all day are the hosts you live beside.
  - Host Village is easy walk from Heritage Site
- Work 2 or 3 days a week 8:40 am – 5:00 pm
- Heritage Site Gate locks at 5pm (Hosts have a key)
